- 2. Up to four scholarships will be awarded at the 2024 Barber County Fair on Sunday prior to the Premium Auction.
- 3. College scholarships shall be paid to the winning applicant(s) upon receipt of verification of enrollment at the college of the applicant's choice.
- 4. The scholarship is available to any 2024 graduate exhibiting at the 2024 Barber County Fair.
- 5. Selection preference will be given to applicants with high levels of: academic achievement; community service; and involvement with 4-H and/ or FFA.
- 6. Applications will be available at the Barber County Extension Office and online at www.barber.ksu.edu.
- 7. Applications must be turned in to the Extension Office by July 9. This is the pre entry deadline for the Fair.
