Dear Fashion Review and Perishable Foods Exhibitors,

Please note we have a few changes or additions this year. I've also covered some of the frequently ask questions below, too.

#### **Perishable Foods:**

Again for 2016 – We would like to collect your recipes. For the 100<sup>th</sup> Fair, in 2020, the Fair Board is going to put out a cookbook. We want to gather your fair recipes from 2015 to 2019 to include. (There will be other chances for EVERYBODY to submit recipes.) Please bring an extra copy.

Remember hot foods must be served at 140 degrees or higher. Oven and a microwave are available if you need to finish cooking or heat up items.

Remember cold foods need to be at 40 degrees or lower. We have 1 refrigerator. Please pack on ice if you have to travel very far.

Tablesettings are done like a demonstration. You will start with a card table with a tablecloth on and explain why you are adding each piece. Example: "My menu is Beef Stew so I am including a soup bowl, soup spoon, plate for the corn bread and a bread knife."

The Poster for the Fair should be ½ of regular poster board. We will take photos at the Judging for you to use in making this poster. These will be available Fair Clean Up or at the Extension Office.

### **Fashion Review:**

New for 2016 – Refreshments will be fresh fruit. We will be preparing it during the Perishable Foods Judging.

We start at 5:00 P.M. for judging. I never know how fast my judges will go. If you are not at the top of the schedule, please be there by 5:00 P.M. to be ready when we get to you. However, I will be there at 4:00 P.M. to set up, if you want to come earlier.

We will decorate right after the judging finishes. With everybody helping, this should be quick. Nicole and Sierra have taken the lead in planning the decorations.

Remember you must bring your clothes on hangers to the Fair. We will hang photos of the outfit, comment forms, and ribbons on them at the Fair. Accessories, props and shoes do not need to be brought to the fair.
