Barber County 4-H Foundation Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. All scholarships may be awarded at the discretion of the Board of Directors 4-H Foundation.
- 2. Up to three \$200 scholarships will be awarded.
- 3. College scholarships shall be paid to the winning applicant(s) upon receipt of verification of enrollment at the college of the applicant's choice. One half of the scholarship shall be paid in the fall semester and one half for the spring semester.
- 4. The scholarship is available to any 2023 graduate enrolled in 4-H and for 1 additional year during college (4-H enrollment not required during college).
- 5. Selection preference will be given to applicants with high levels of: academic achievement; community service; and involvement with 4-H.
- 6. Applications will be available at the Barber County Extension Office and online at www.barber.ksu.edu.
- 7. Applications must be turned in to the Extension Office by January 31.
