Barber County Fair Association Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. All scholarships may be awarded at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Association.
- 2. Up to four \$500 scholarships will be awarded at the 2018 Barber County Fair on Sunday prior to the Premium Auction.
- 3. College scholarships shall be paid to the winning applicant(s) upon receipt of verification of enrollment at the college of the applicant's choice. One half of the scholarship shall be paid in the fall semester and one half for the spring semester.
- 4. The scholarship is available to any 2018 graduate exhibiting at the 2018 Barber County Fair.
- 5. Selection preference will be given to applicants with high levels of: academic achievement; community service; and involvement with 4-H and/or FFA.
- 6. Applications will be available at the Barber County Extension Office and online at www.barber.ksu.edu.
- 7. Applications must be turned in to the Extension Office by July 9. This is the pre entry deadline for the Fair.
